Following breakfast will be the IOCA meeting. If people want more trips can go out.

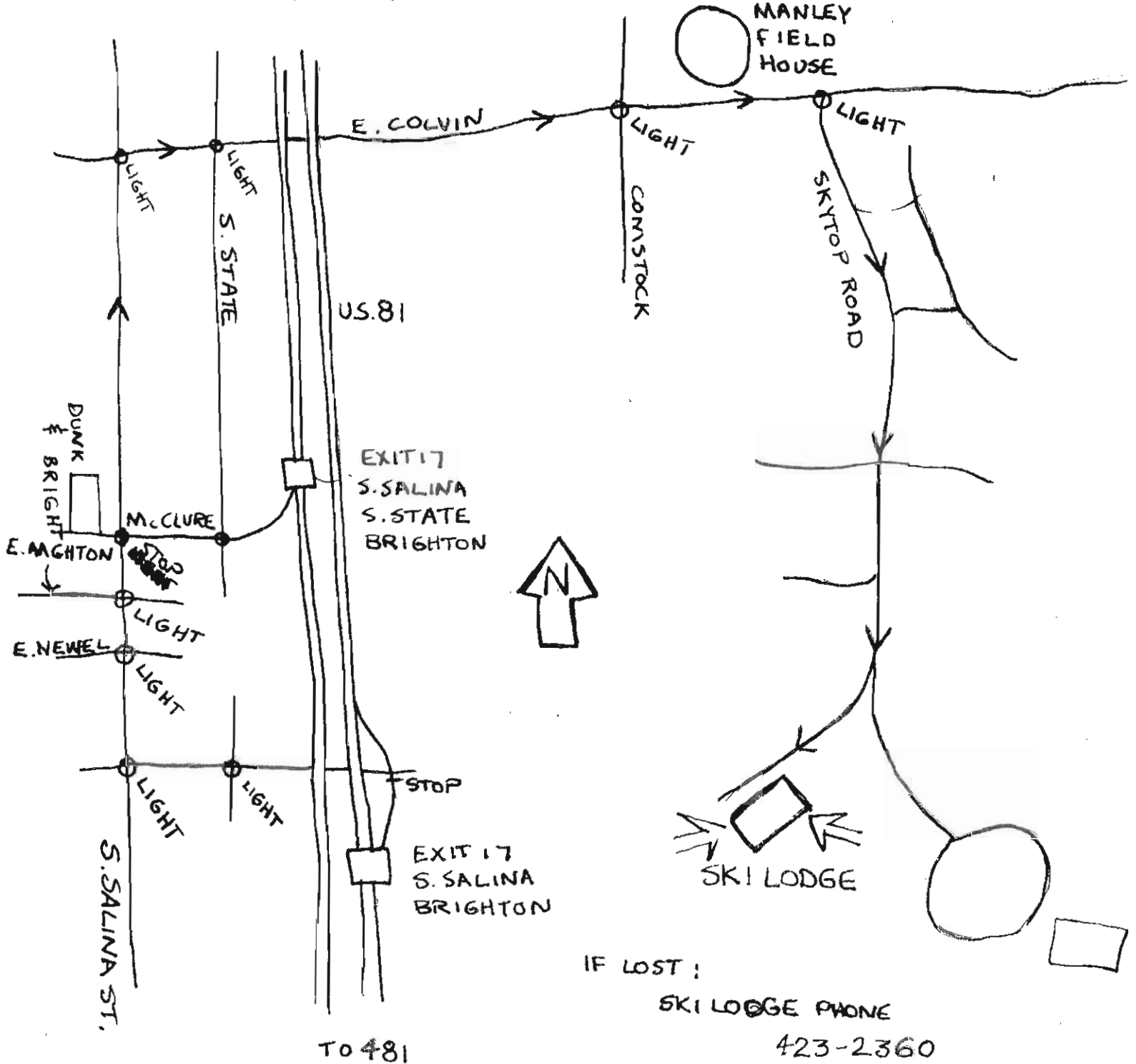
The cost for the weekend will be approximately \$8-10.00. I can give you a price breakdown when you get to Syracuse.
