WHAT IS KAMAJI???

Kamaji is a residential summer camp for girls located in Northern Minnesota. Each summer, 160 girls (ages 7-15) and 80+ staff members come together to enjoy the magic of camping.

WHAT DOES A WILDERNESS TRIP LEADER DO???

"Trippers" take small groups of campers and their counselors on overnight canoe/kayak/climbing/camping trips ranging in length of 2 - 10 days.

WHAT QUALIFICATIONS DO I NEED TO BE A TRIPPER???

- Training and significant experience in wilderness camping, canoeing and/or kayaking (documented)
- Current Wilderness First Aid and Lifeguarding certifications (or willingness to acquire certs before beginning contractual period)
- Ability to teach camping/canoeing/kayaking skills to campers and/or staff
- Desire and ability to work with children outdoors
- Possess good judgment, leadership and decision-making skills
- Good character, integrity, and adaptability
- Enthusiasm, sense of humor, patience, and self-control
- Dependable and able to uphold a commitment
- Ability to relate to one's peer group
- Ability to accept supervision and guidance
- Must be at least 21 years of age; males or females welcome

WHAT IS THE SUMMER EMPLOYMENT PERIOD???

June 1st until August 12th, 2009.

WHAT IS THE SALARY???

Competitive Salary based upon education, experience, qualifications, etc. Salaries range from \$2100 to \$2500 for the minimum employment period of June 1st through August 12th. Additional compensation is provided in the form of room and board plus a transportation allowance ranging from \$100 to \$400. Additional weekly salary beginning at \$200 per week for pre- and post-season work.
